#### **Travel Grant**

\*GMs, IMs, WGMs, WIMs, with the ELO of 2300 (2200 for WIMs) will be given a travel grant of Rs. 10,000/=

\*All foreign players will provide free transport facilities from airport to hotel & hotel to airport.

#### **Entry Fee**

All title players (FM/WFM and above) and players having a rating of above 2200 are free.
