All the foreign unrated players and accompanying person have to bare their own expenses.

Local outstation players can be accommodated with a nominal charge.

Travel Grant

*GMs, IMs, WGMs, WIMs, with the ELO of 2300 (2200 for WIMs) will be given a travel grant of Rs. 10,000/=

*All foreign players will provide free transport facilities from airport to hotel & hotel to airport.

Entry Fee

All title players (FM/WFM and above) and players having a rating of above 2200 are free.

Rating category 2000 - 2200: Rs. 1000/=

Rating category 1800 to 2000: Rs. 1,500/=

Rating category 1600 to 1800: Rs. 2,000/=

Rating category less than 1600: Rs. 2,500/=

Unrated players: Rs. 3,500/=

All amounts are in Sri Lankan Rupees.

Late fee of Rs. 500/= will be charged for the entries received after 1st October 2011. This applies for rated players, whom can do registration even via Email, as well.


