Junior National Chess Championship Qualifying 2015

The Chess Federation of Sri Lanka is organizing the Sri Lanka Junior National (Boys and Girls separate) Qualifying Tournaments on **08th, 09th and 10th of May 2015** in **Colombo (Royal College), Galle and Kurunegala**. The **Kandy event** will be held on **15th, 16th and 17th of May**.

All those who are born in 1995 and after are eligible to play.

All Rated Players, Players who played in the National B/ Women's National B 2015, Players who played in the World School Chess Championship 2015 have direct entry into the Sri Lanka Junior National Championships.

The **Entry Fee is Rs 400**. All players who register via email will have to pay the entry fees before the end of the first round. **The Players are expected to hand over payments and not wait for the Arbiters to come asking for payments. Failure to do so will result in the name being excluded from the subsequent pairings.**

The events will be held according to the Swiss System in 5 rounds. Winners will be awarded with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals and certificates

2. Bucholz Score Minus Weakest Score - Cut One Bucholz (37 -1,0,N,Y,0, N)
3. Bucholz Score Minus Two Weakest Scores - Cut Two Bucholz (37 -2,0,N,Y,0, N)
4. FIDE Tie Break – Progressive Score (8)

Players are to refrain from communicating with each other while the games are in progress. Continuous failure to comply could lead to the loss of the game.
