Organization (CSO) or Higher Education Institute (HEI), the player should be informed the event organizer before starting the 2nd round. The player should have proper approval from the representing CSO / HEI to do so. There should be minimum 3 players from the same CSO / HEI to claim a team prize. Any number of players can represent the same CSO / HEI. The team place will be decided by the top five players of the same CSO / HEI. Only one team place can be claimed by one CSO / HEI. None can represent both categories.

ACCOMODATION

- •All the Foreign players with more than 2000 ELO Rating will be provided accommodation with three meals.
- •All other foreign Rated players will be provided with accommodation only.
- •All those who needs A/C Rooms Accommodation has to pay an extra fee 20\$ per night.
- •GMs, WGMs, IMs, WIMs may contact Organizers Directly.
- •All the Foreign Unrated players and accompanying person have bare their own expenses.
- •Local Outstation players can be accommodated with normal charge.

All local players should be registered with the CFSL to play in this event

TRAVEL GRANT

- •GMs,WGMs,IMs with ELO 2300 or above (2200 or above for WIMs) will be given a travel grant of 20,000/= LKR
- •All the foreign players will provide free transport facilities from Airport to Hotel and Hotel to Airport.
