Time Control: 5 minutes per player per game. Digital clocks will be used for the top boards as available. Analog clocks will be used for the rest.

Pairing and tie breaks will be carried out by the Swiss Manager program with FIDE Tie breaks used.

Eligibility

Open to all. However registration is limited to 100 players on first come first serve basis. Rest based on slots freed up by non participation of PMCC members and personally invited players.

Entry Fee

An Entry Fee of Rs. 1200.00 will be charged from all local players.

USD 20.00 will be charged from foreign players.

Rs 100.00 will be refunded at the venue for players who bring their own digital clock. A late fee of Rs. 500.00 will be charged for entrees received after 08th August 2011.

Under no circumstances will entrees be accepted after 12 noon 12th August 2011.
